1. Purpose

From 1991, Yazaki Corporation's branch in Samoa, Yazaki EDS Samoa Ltd. (hereinafter "YES"), was developed with great support and efforts of the people in Samoa. Due to a change in business environment, Yazaki Corporation had to make a decision to close YES and end its 26-year history in 2017. Although YES closes, Yazaki Corporation targets to support and contribute to the Independent State of Samoa. To pursue this aim, Yazaki Corporation has inaugurated Yazaki Kizuna Foundation to provide scholarships to those who are eager to contribute to Samoa's development and pursue an academic career but who are in need of financial support.
